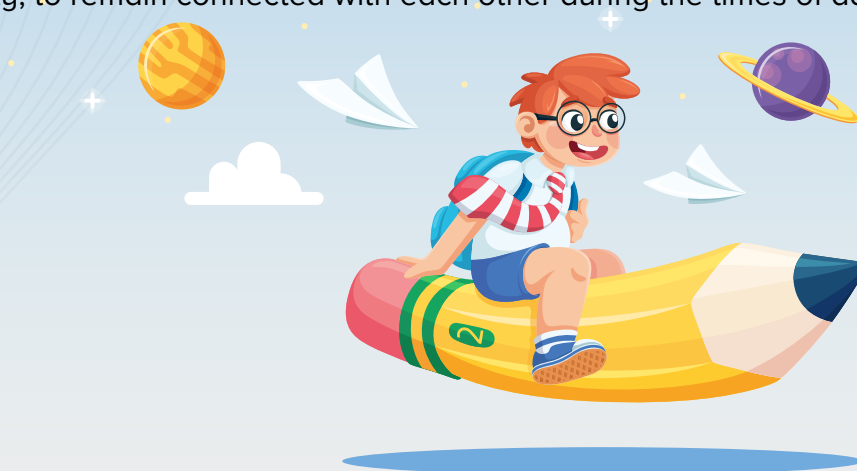
Reopening Ceremony

The Principal of TWS expressed her concerns on increasing levels of gaming addictions in children and drew the attention of parents on it. She advised the parents to monitor their child's online activity and spend quality time with their wards.

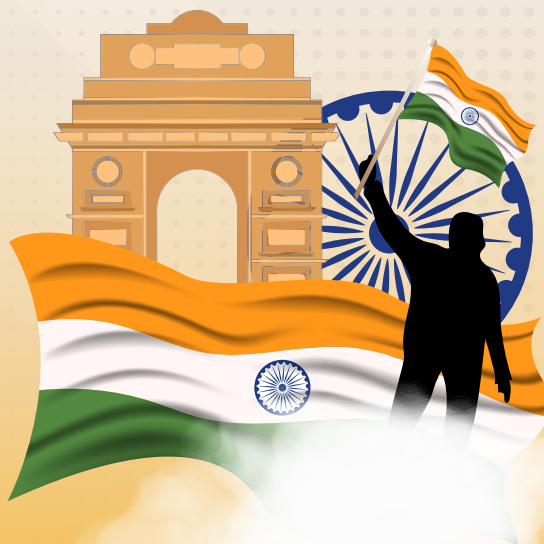


Independence Day

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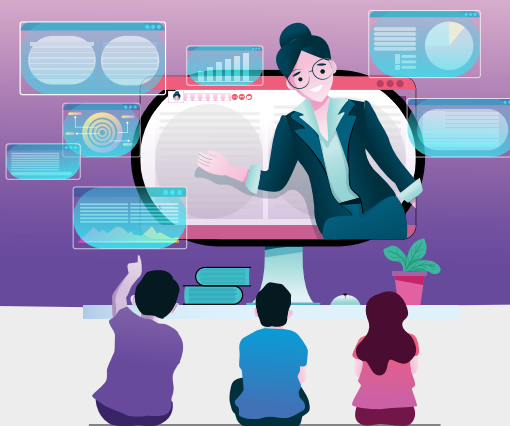
Teacher's Day

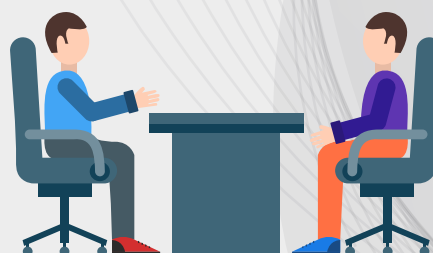


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Parent-Teacher Meeting
